

## JAMES BEARD PUBLIC MARKET RECEIVES \$500K DONATION, REACHES \$3M FUNDRAISING MARK



Barry Menashe and his family donates to the James Beard Market Fundraiser, helping to catalyze the growth of the market's development. The funds will support the purchase of a 17,290-square-foot building at 622 S.W. Alder St. in downtown Portland, formerly home to a Rite Aid.

In addition, the market plans to lease ground-floor space at 610 S.W. Alder St., creating a combined footprint of nearly **40,000 square feet**. This expansive project will house 40 new small businesses, including a teaching kitchen, event space, and a variety of local offerings such as a restaurant, bakery, fish market, butcher, cheese shop, wine merchant, and farm stalls, showcasing the best of Oregon's culinary and agricultural heritage.

As a new neighbor for various Menashe Properties buildings, such as the **American Bank Building**, **610 Building**, and the **Electric building**,

Barry Menashe Family Fund contributes to the success of the new market to help promote community support amongst the local businesses in the Pioneer Square area of Downtown Portland.
